

Termination/ Fraud Policy

Choices for Children may terminate a family from the program for any of the following:

Initials	1.	Delinquency in payment of the family fee.
Initials	2.	Collaborating with other individuals to commit fraudulent acts.
Initials	3.	If you are enrolled and currently receiving services from another alternative payment program for childcare services in Santa Clara or any other county in California. <u>Example</u> : Go Kids or Department of Social Services
Initials	4.	Failure to provide current and correct information as requested at certification or recertification.
Initials	5.	Fraudulent, false, or misleading documentation regarding training programs, schools, medical incapacitation, employment and/or income.
Initials	6.	Harassing conduct towards employees, as defined in CFC's Parent Handbook.
Initials	7.	Per parent request.
Initials	8.	For Cause
